



Are you co-habiting with bats? They need your help! Be kind to them!

Bats sometimes seek shelter in buildings for a few days or a few months. If you can offer them shelter, it will contribute to their survival.

- Make sure they are excluded from your living areas.
- Register your bat colony at batwatch.ca.

Unfounded fears about bats?

Contrary to popular belief, bats:

- are not rodents, pests, or vermin.
- do not cause structural damage to buildings.
- do not burrow into building materials.

Bats use existing, often unused spaces, on a temporary basis;

They help naturally and effectively to fight against nuisance insects and other pests.

There are effective ways of getting bats to leave your home without causing them any harm.

- Before taking any action against them, visit the website: batwatch.ca
- Avoid any direct contact with the bats.
- Avoid excluding them between May and the end of September.
