Several species of bats in Quebec are endangered.

Bats in decline

- White-nose syndrome (WNS), an infection caused by a fungus from Europe, has produced a catastrophic decline in several North American species of bats.
- While it poses no problem for human health, this fungus is responsible for the death of up to 99% of the bats in certain colonies.

Contribute to their survival!

- Save old trees (called "snags") that are still standing;
- Maintain woodlots near bodies of water:
- Avoid displacing bats from their roosts between May and the end of September;
- Avoid visiting caves in winter;
- Stop using pesticides;
- Put up a bat house;
- · Limit lighting around houses at night;
- Talk to your friends and neighbours about the plight of bats and what they can do to help!
- Share your observations about bats.
